Grades K-8 Progress Testing

The first of our three rounds of progress testing (Measures of Academic Progress or MAP Tests) will be taking place this week through September 10. MAP is a nationally recognized, computer adaptive assessment tool which we use to monitor student learning and improve instruction for grades K-8. There are three to four hours of testing that will be spread out over the course of two weeks. We will plan to share the results of the testing with parents at our Parent-Teacher Conferences in the third full week of September.

Mr. Mattes will be taking over Language Arts (DGP, Spelling) while Mrs. Schroder does Literature in grades 5 & 6. See the general article for more information. Spelling: No Spelling this week due to short week and MAP testing

English: Daily Grammar Practice Week 2 **Literature**: *The True Confessions of Charlotte Doyle* begin Part 2

Math: Course 2 (Jaeger) will continue with rational numbers. Course 3 is continuing to study exponents. Algebra 1 is solving equations with adding, subtracting, multiplying, and dividing.

Word of God: Lesson 3 "How can I learn the Truth?"
