Health & Safety Plan UPDATED

NCA families can review the current [health and safety plan at this link](#). This plan was recently updated at the October 11 School Ministry Board meeting. The following changes go into effect October 25:

- Parents/guardians now have the choice to continue sending their child(ren) to school if they have been exposed to a COVID-19 positive case (as long as they continue to be asymptomatic) or quarantine for no more than 7 days.
- Discontinue daily temperature checks as students are dropped off at the beginning of the school day.
- Resume weekly in-person chapel for grades K-8.
