- McKay Scholarship

Reminder: The FTC, FES-EO and FES-UA programs are once-in, always-in meaning students who utilized the scholarship for the 2021-22 school year (including McKay students) will NOT need to submit documents to demonstrate their eligibility AND will have funding priority. the scholarship to your 2022-2023 financial agreement.
