

Qty	Item	Important Details
1	Backpack	
1	Lunchbox	
1	Water bottle	Can be kept at child's desk
1	Sterilite Small clear clipbox	This container is slightly larger than a pencil box (can be found at Publix) *see bottom of page for image
12	Glue sticks	
2 (10 count)	Crayola Markers	no more than 10 (original colors, includes black)
2 (24 count)	Crayola Crayons	no more than 24
(optional)	Colored Pencils	No more than 24
1	Fiskar Scissors	Blunt tip
1 (48 count)	#2 Pencils	No mechanical pencils please, Sharpened
1 (at Least)	Hi-Polymer block Eraser	Brands include- Pentel, Artellius, and Mr. Pen (can be found at Walmart and staples) *art department
optional	Pencil top Erasers	
1 (4 count)	EXPO fine tip dry erase markers	Red, black, green, and blue (other colors don't erase well)
1	Wide ruled Composition book	Smooth cover, any color
1	Primary Journal Half page	(can be found at Walmart)
1	1-inch Binder	Any color/design
2	Solid orange folders with clasps	Plastic not Paper please
2	Solid yellow folders with clasps	Plastic not Paper please
2	Folders with Pockets	Any color or design
1	Headphones	
1	Spare change of clothes	Socks, shorts, underwear, shirt (in a ziploc bag with your child's name)

1 (optional)	Stuffed Animal	For quite time, taken home daily
1 box	Quart-sized Ziploc bags	Classroom Community supplies
4	Small Facial tissues	Classroom Community supplies
2 or 3	Pre-Moistened disinfecting wipes	Classroom Community supplies
Optional	Band Aids	Any kind, they work magic!

Please label markers, crayons, etc... with your child's name or initials. Folders, Composition book, primary journal, and Binder can be labeled on the top of the inside cover. Mailing labels are fine and save time. Please sharpen all pencils prior to school if possible.

Pencils, Pencil top erasers, EXPO Markers, Tissues, disinfecting wipes, and Ziploc bags do **NOT** need to be labeled.

These items will be classroom community supplies.
