Reading: Last week we began our Superkid reading program. The first series in this program is called *Meet the Superkids.* Each book features a different Superkid who will help your child learn about one letter of the alphabet. Last week we met Cass. Cass introduced us to the letter c and it's sound /k/. This week will learn how to write the letter Cc and practice identifying words with the initial /k/ sound.

Writing: Last week we discussed how people use pictures to tell stories. We practiced tracing curved lines and circles. We will continue to practice drawing shapes and lines. You can reinforce this skill at home with your child. If you have time, watch your child write their name. Encourage your child to use a correct pencil grip and letter formation. 
