Safety is our primary concern when your child is dropped of and picked up. In order to keep your child safe, increase pick up efficiency, and keep traffic from backing up onto Mapledale Blvd., NCA has implemented the following parking lot procedure. <u>Drop Off Notes</u>: If you want to walk your child into the classroom, park only in the designated areas on the parking lot map. Please use caution when exiting the parking lot.

<u>Pick Up Notes</u>: Please follow the blue arrows on the parking lot map and avoid cutting in front of other drivers. Please observe the designated dismissal times based on the following schedule:
