Playground Fundraising Update

The first ever NCA walk-a-thon was a tremendous success! Our immediate and extended NCA family was moved to give \$13,517 toward our playground improvement project! We give thanks to God for blessing our families and the efforts of this fundraiser so generously. Our current total for playground fundraising from all sources is \$40,412. The goal is \$50,000. All we need is another 20 families to donate \$500 each or 10 families to donate \$1,000 and we will be at our goal.
