Parking Lot Safety

Safety is our primary concern when your child is dropped of and picked up. Please review the linked map so you are well informed of these safety procedures. Please use caution when exiting the parking lot. Pick Up Notes: Please follow the blue arrows on the parking lot map and avoid cutting in front of other drivers whenever possible. Before School Care

3K & VPK before school care checks-in at the 3K/VPK classroom. K-8 before school care checks-in at the main academy building. Please ring the bell for assistance getting your child checked in.

After School Care

3K through 2nd grade after school care signs-out at the 3K/VPK classroom. 3rd through 8th grade after school care signs-out at the main church building. If you are picking up from after school care, you can ring the bell for assistance getting your child signed out. There are signs indicating which doors to use when picking up children from after care. Please keep in mind the group may be outside for recess when you come to pick up.
