<u>Hurricane Milton Planning</u>

NCA leadership is closely monitoring Hurricane Milton developments. NCA will remain open Monday, October 7. A plan for Tuesday/Wednesday will be announced Monday by 7:00 PM. Hillsborough public schools will be closed starting Monday in order to prepare shelters. We do not fill that role in our community which is why we are staying open on Monday. If you decide your child won't be at school, please let us know by contacting the office or the classroom teacher. Look for an update via email and text no later than 7:00 PM on Monday.

End of First Quarter & Attendance
