Hurricane Response & Planning

Our community has been through a lot this hurricane season. While we have many reasons to give thanks to God for his preservation during these natural disasters, some have been impacted more seriously than others. It has been awesome to see the many ways neighbors have been helping each other as we go about the recovery and restoration efforts. We will need to make up one school day due to all our hurricane days. More details will be shared in the online forum and future newsletters.

Hurricane Relief Efforts

If you would like to donate to the hurricane relief and recovery efforts impacting our affiliated churches, schools, and their communities, the best way is through our church body's humanitarian aid program: Christian Aid and Relief. The website to donate is WELS.net/CARgift. Every dollar given supports those impacted by natural disasters. WELS Christian Aid and Relief works with our churches and missions in the impacted area to help the congregation and community clean up and rebuild. They provide funding, equipment, and trained volunteer labor when appropriate. It is a great blessing of our church body in rebuilding churches, schools, serving communities, and restoring lives. Christian Aid and Relief visited our campus in the days following Hurricane Milton. We were awarded a grant to help with the following recovery efforts:

- Removing a large tree that fell on the main academy building
- Repairing roof damage due to the tree
- Repairing our NCA sign
- Replacing playground mulch that was lost due to high
- Replacing damaged audio/visual electronics
- Remediating and replacing drywall and furniture that was damaged when rain water entered the building
