Preferred Enrollment for NCA Families Now Open

NCA has opened preferred enrollment for current NCA families, their siblings, and members of Northdale Lutheran Church through January 31. Currently enrolled students who are returning will complete this re-enrollment process. The enrollment fee (K-8 only) will be \$400 per child through January 31. The fee will increase to \$500 February 1 and \$600 March 1. The full <u>tuition and fee schedule for 2025-2026</u> is available on our website. Look for a January 2 email from TADS with re-enrollment directions. Should the enrollment fee present any challenges or if you have any questions about this process, please contact Mr. Mattes directly.

Current families with siblings new to NCA need to complete the <u>online application for enrollment</u> prior to January 31 to qualify for preferred enrollment. The \$100 application fee will appear as a credit on your first tuition payment. <u>Only new students need to complete the</u> <u>application for enrollment</u>. New family applications for 2025-2026 are already being received and will be given enrollment opportunity starting February 1.
